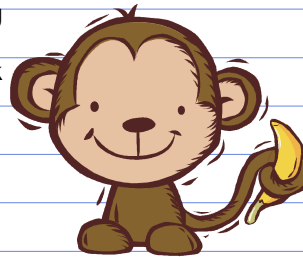


Wild About 4th Grade!

Clarifications

As a new year starts, there are always questions about procedures, curriculum, and various other items. Please review the following clarifications, and call, email, or write a note if you have any other questions.

- ✓ Daily homework is comprised of assignments the student does not finish during class time. 20 minutes of reading five nights per week is also expected. The Reading Log must be filled out and signed. The first week, we will fill the Reading Log out together in class. Each student's first Reading Log will be due August 30th.
- ✓ Homework that is one day late, will receive 75% credit. Homework that is two days late, will receive 50% credit. No credit will be given for assignments that are more than two days late.
- ✓ If a student does not put his/her name on his/her paper, the assignment will receive 75% credit. This rule will go into effect Sept. 1st.
- ✓ Planners come home daily. Students write down all of the assignments that we do in class each day. If they did not complete the assignment, they highlight it. If the assignment is not completed in class, it is homework. Please initial planners daily.
- ✓ Parents, please get your Portal Password from Mrs. Erker in the office, so you are able to keep up with your student's progress each week.
