- I. Minutes approval
- II. Membership discussion – Ellen thanked Kathleen Harrison and Susan Barrier for their service. Several names were brought forward for possible contact to invite to the first fall meeting. Ellen represents middle school, Tara represents the secondary, so a primary rep is needed. All current teachers will stay on the committee. Ellen and April will work on a handout of what the committee does to present at the fall meeting.
- III. Review of the Parent Satisfaction Survey – there were 69 responses. Ellen asked that the committee use the data in the survey to name three things that would make them want to bring their child to CCA and then to name one thing they would like to change about CCA. The list of why would you bring your child to CCA – safety, director, good communication, PTO, friendly front staff and aids, drama, good leadership, high satisfaction. The list of the one thing to change – the image that staff and board children are treated differently than other children, change the art and music spaces, have better observation and supervision at recess, consistent grading, same people are in “power” positions, communicate what is happening at the board to the stakeholders, perception that the CCA curriculum has changed with the standards, clear up the difference between core knowledge and common core standards, discipline. The July meeting will focus on brainstorming for this list.
- IV. Good of the order – there are some changes with the state and with how we will report. Soon the state will have a format of what our Accountability Report will need to look like in the future. The district is dropping Acuity testing and adopting NWEA Maps in its place – Kindergarten and up. There will be three testing points per year and the testing will take approximately ½ of the time. We will continue to test in Science for progress monitoring.
- V. Meetings – there will be no meeting in June. In July, we will meet on the 12 for a lunch and brainstorming session. The first meeting in the fall will be on August 18.
